CAUTION

NOTE—A Passport is a valuable document and should not be allowed to pass into the possession of an unauthorised person. If lost or destroyed, the fact should be immediately reported to the Passport Control Office, Kampala, or to the nearest British authorities. New Passports can only be issued in such cases after exhaustive enquiries have been made.
